- 1. Justin Martin joined team. Members invited to review committee spreadsheet shared on screen to indicate any changes. SRC stated they would share their new SVP class reps contact info once decided.
- 2. Previous Minutes Approved.
- 3. Updates
 - Alex and Andrea provided update on recent Flip the Script program (Nov 18+25).
 11 women were trained for the first time since bringing the program to St. Clair College. SVP Student Ambassadors are to finalize their training by participating in Wen-Do Women's Self Defense Dec 3-5 and will be preparing to offer the training in-person in 2023.
 - Rebecca and Beth provided an overview from the Campus Sexual Violence Training (Oct 31, Nov 1, 14, 15) facilitated by Osgoode via York University. Findings included pathways for reporting and enabling wraparound supports on/off campus.

4. Actions

- a. Wen-Do Women's Self Defense
 - Deb Chard (Wen-Do, Toronto) will be coming down on Dec 3-5 and training staff/students in women's self defense (max 20 participants). This is part of our facilitator training for Flip the Script.
- b. Bringing in the Bystander (for all students)
 - i. Onboarding/training to finalize in the beginning of January. Dates to be determined with ambassadors at end of Dec. Alex & Andrea to offer to staff/faculty in February 2023.
- 5. Promotion & Awareness
 - a. Branding
